

## A Legacy Gift toward the work of the Kingwood Trust

If you wish to add a provision to leave money to Kingwood this should in general be possible through the addition of a simple codicil, rather than requiring a new will to be drawn up. Your solicitor will be able to advise how this can best be done in relation to your existing will. A few points which may be helpful -

A *Beneficiary* – a person or organisation that benefits from your will.

A *Legacy or Bequest* – a gift you leave in your will to a person or organisation.

Such gifts are often of the following forms -

*Pecuniary legacy* – a gift of a specific sum of money

*Residuary legacy* – a legacy that represents the whole (or a percentage of) the value of your estate after other gifts and all taxes and other liabilities have been deducted.

A *Codicil* – a legally binding document made by you which alters or adds to your existing will.

*Executor or Executrix* – A person you appoint to carry out your wishes as stated in your will and to administer your estate after your death.

You should always consult your own professional advisers before making a decision.
